When is the auction?

Saturday, April 6th, 2024! Doors open at Rock Garden at 5:30pm and will end around 10pm. Book a sitter for your kiddos as this is an adult-only event. Invite your friends and family – all are welcome!!

What should I wear?

If you love to dress up, find some 1990's garb and go all out! You'll be in good company as lots of attendees love to dress to our themes, especially a fun theme like Rewind to the 90s. You'll also find many attendees in everyday jeans and a nice top or general dressy attire. You'll fit in whichever you choose!

What happens at the auction?

Doors open at 5:30pm. Enjoy some delicious hors d'oeuvres and cocktails while browsing hundreds of items up for bid. Purchase raffle tickets for our new Bourbon & Meat Raffle and Mystery Grab Bags! Silent sections start closing at 7:30 pm, the live auction starts at 8:30 pm and our Spotlight section closes at 9:30 pm. The Big Cash Raffle is drawn at 10:00 pm (need not be present to win). Lots of socializing, laughter and fun!

Should I eat before arriving?

Admission tickets include a light buffet featuring meatballs, chicken drumettes, veggie egg rolls, pretzel bites, and more, plus a fun 1990's candy assortment. Eat before or at the auction – it's up to you!

What does it cost to attend?

\$35 per person if registered by 3/24/24 (\$45 after). *(Note: Free admission given to several sponsor levels!)*

What is the Big Cash Raffle?

3. Can you donate an experience? Perhaps you love decorating cookies and could host a small class at your home or school. Perhaps where you work can be a fun tour for kids. If you love to cook, you could host a dinner at your home. If you have a boat, you could host a day of tubing for kids or an evening cruise for adults. Experiences are great money-makers for our auction!
4. Cash – cash is always helpful for a random array of auction event needs.



Item Suggestions Sorted into Themes, by Grade:

PRESCHOOL –

Baby Love: Board books, gender neutral onesies/blankets, bibs, diaper bag, infant toys, teething rings, burp cloths, baby hooded towels, baby socks/slippers, etc.

Arts and Crafts: Scissors, glue, markers, construction paper, pipe cleaners, modeling clay, moon sand, painting supplies, craft kits, beads, glitter, fabric, canvas boards, etc.

KINDERGARTEN –

Kids Fun: Toys, Legos, getting ready for kindergarten games, stuffed animals, pillows, squishimals, LOL's, Barbies, Pokemon, unicorns, Hatchimals, puzzle books, doll items, etc.

Baking or Ice Cream: Kids' cookbook, kids' utensils, baking mixes, and/or kitchen stuff, ice cream sundae fixings/dishes, birthday accessories such as candles, plates/cups/napkins, etc.

1ST GRADE –

Summer Fun: Beach towels, beach toys, yard games, sunglasses, sprinkler, water balloons, bubbles, chalk, kickball, bases, sunscreen, book of outdoor fun ideas, etc.

Beverages: Coffee, tea, soda, wine, beer, alcohol

2ND GRADE–

Outdoor Adventure: Sleeping bags, fishing poles/lures, mini lanterns, flashlights, s'mores fixings, head lamps, bug spray, citronella candles, collapsible wagon, ponchos, pudgy pie makers, first aid kit, fire pit, grill, etc.

Home Décor: Decorative pillows, blankets, frames, wood signs, vases, dishes, notes/menu chalkboard, hook racks, door wreaths, stationery/desk organizers, lamps, storage bins, etc.

3RD GRADE –

Pampering: Bubble bath, bath salts, slippers, facial masks, eye mask, candles, books, massage gift certificate, foot bath, lotions, mani/pedi supplies or certificates, heating pad, etc.

Sports: Golf balls/tees, kids' active wear, soccer ball, football, basketball, sport gloves, duffel bags or sport bags, sport socks, water bottles, Packers/Badgers/Brewers jerseys, etc.

4TH GRADE –

Rainy Day Fun: Movie passes, blankets, DVDs, candy, board games, toys, fuzzy socks, popcorn, passes for anything fun to do around Green Bay (trampoline parks, open gyms, etc.)

Beverages: Coffee, tea, soda, wine, beer, alcohol

5TH GRADE –

Tween Appeal: Jewelry, makeup, books, hair accessories, purses, notepads, puzzle games, baseball cards, video games for Wii/Playstation/Nintendo, etc.

Electronics: computer mouse, wireless earbuds, Bluetooth speakers, power banks, headphones, wireless chargers, USB memory drives, USB gadgets, charging stations, etc.

6TH GRADE –

Dinner Night: Non-perishable ingredients for meals (Italian, Mexican, Chinese, etc.), wine, kitchen accessories, cheese board, cutting boards, knives, BBQ tools, sauces, serving platters, seasoning, grill cleaner/brush, etc.

7TH GRADE –

Macho Man: Car care supplies, specialty beers, nuts/snack mixes, multi-tools, specialty tools, Packers/Badgers/Brewers accessories, Yeti tumblers, Hard-sided cooler, beef jerky, etc.

Beverages: Coffee, tea, soda, wine, beer, alcohol

8TH GRADE –

Health and Wellness: Vitamins/supplements, water bottles, protein shakes, men's or women's workout gear, at home workout equipment, Fitness DVD's, healthy snacks, essential oils, etc.
